## GOVT. PARTNERSHIPS

## FOUNDER STORY

Driven by concerns about health, education, and equality for vulnerable women as an integral and critical dimension of human rights, Ladli Foundation became a reality in 2012 as a grassroots social catalyst. It was founded by Devendra Kumar, whose incredible journey began as a child labourer in a poverty-stricken environment. He faced numerous hardships and atrocities during his orphaned and challenging childhood. Born in a crime-prone slum, he endured abandonment by his parents, who left him with his three-day-old infant sister when he was just two years old. Despite these adversities, Devendra's indomitable spirit and resilience led him to find solace and purpose in serving others.

Driven by his determination to protect his sister from child marriage and dowry, Devendra founded the "Ladli Foundation" with the noble mission of uplifting the oppressed and disadvantaged. His personal experiences as a child laborer and his encounters with delinquents and drug addicts further fueled his commitment to making a positive impact on the lives of those facing similar challenges.

# ABOUT FOUNDER



Devendra Kumar, a young self-made grassroots social worker, emerged from the depths of a crime-ridden slum where his parents abandoned him and his infant sister at the tender age of two. Growing up in poverty, at the age of 8, he began his journey as a child labourer by selling balloons for his survival. However, his path was fraught with danger as he often fell victim to assaults by gangs of delinquents and drug addicts. These hardships drove him to seek safe shelter and led him to volunteer in community policing Initiatives with the Delhi Police. In 2010, his struggle to save his sister from child marriage and dowry while living in extremely vulnerable circumstances motivated him to work for the most vulnerable communities, for which he established the "Ladli Foundation." Over time, volunteering became his passion, and he took early financial retirement at the age of 35 to devote himself full-time to volunteering to live his passion. This is how the power of volunteering helped shape him into a notable social reformer who has impacted the lives of millions, which he never envisioned.

He has been honoured with two National Awards from the Government of India and has received appreciation from four successive Presidents of India, including the Late Shri. APJ Abdul Kalam, Late. Sh. Pranab Mukherjee, Sh. Ram Nath Kovind, and currently Smt. Draupadi Murmu. His remarkable social contributions were recognised by the Union Ministry of Social Justice, Government of India, which nominated him for the prestigious Padma Shri in 2020, the fourth-highest civilian award in India. His unwavering efforts in liberating thousands of women and young girls from sexual abuse and exploitation, while empowering them towards self-reliance, earned him the title of "True Hero" from Bollywood Superstar Mr Amitabh Bachchan.

Currently, he is dedicated to tackling the most pressing social issues concerning health and education for the vulnerable populations residing in slums, striving for sustainable development in India by managing the force of over 1.5 Lakh+ Youth Interns & Volunteers through his innovative Social Internship Program.

In 2017, His most significant gender sensitisation initiative for gathering 20,000 male participants in the Run for Ladli Half Marathon at JLN Stadium, Delhi, to uphold the idea of Gender Equality was witnessed and praised by the Union Home Minister, the Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment, numerous international diplomats and government officials. His 23 years of continuous actions and innovative initiatives for empowering the oppressed and disadvantaged have also drawn attention on a global scale at the United Nations, where his suggestions have been published twice in high-level political forums.

Devendra is an emerging global leader, a notable speaker and a public policy analyst with extensive expertise in international relations and the development sector. He is also the founder of the South and East Asia Foundation in India, serving as an international think tank that has successfully orchestrated prestigious conferences like INDIA & BRICS, INDO-US SUMMIT, INDO-CHINA SUMMIT, CLIMATE CONCLAVE, and NATIONAL DEMOCRACY SUMMIT, uniting global leaders, diplomats, and policymakers to address India's challenges. Beyond diplomacy, he is committed to gender-sensitive societal reform, fostering a network of change-makers dedicated to advancing gender equality.

His quote, "Society is like a Canvas, it's you who needs to paint it beautifully", serves as the driving force behind his transformative leadership initiatives aimed at creating a more inclusive world.

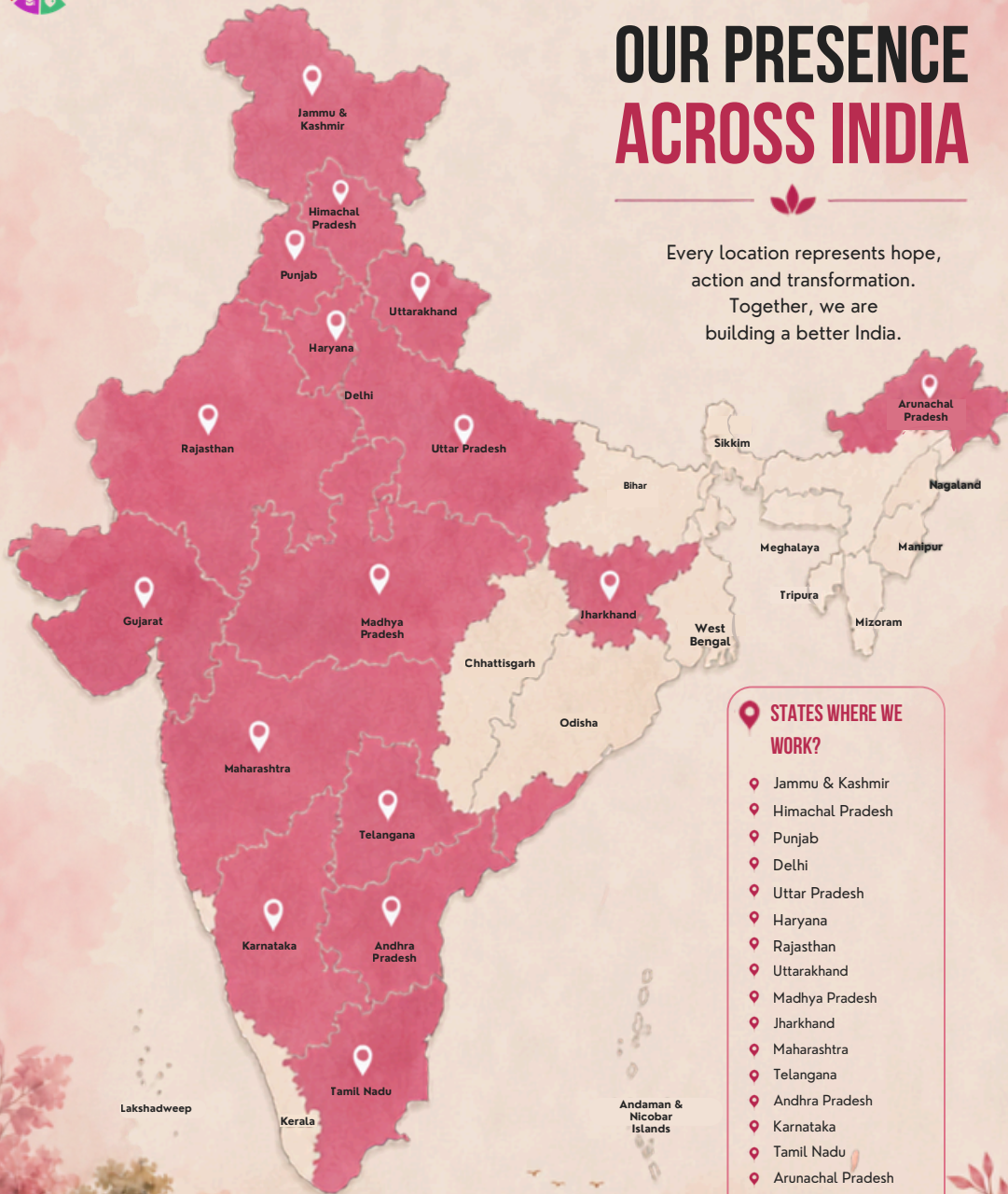

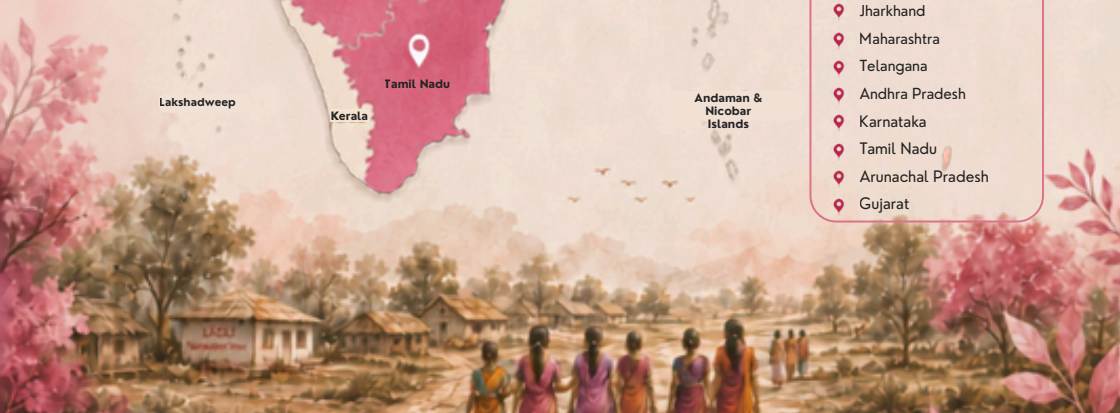

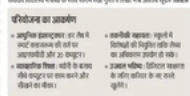

During the UNGA in January, a number of selected names were discussed from across the world, in which the name of Ladli Foundation Trust was proposed unopposed from India for this special status, on which the final decision by the Council has been given recently, wherein the Ladli Foundation Trust officially achieved the recognition.  
After receiving this special honor, the organization will be allowed to represent and give written suggestions to the United Nations on the subjects related to the Council. The trust will also have the privilege of making a seven members delegation that can attend

meeting at the United Nations Headquarters, New York, Geneva, Vienna and other regional headquarters.  
The Ladli Foundation has directly benefited more than 6 lakh adolescent girls and women, through mass marriages, adult education, medical camps, and personal hygiene kits distribution through its active units in more than 50 districts of the country, along with Delhi Police. Meanwhile, together, by making more than 5 lakh youth

aware on social issues, thousands of youth have been saved from the clutches of drug and crime through sports.  
The founder of the Ladli Foundation, Devendra Kumar Gupta, told Top Story that his organization has been selected for this important position by the United Nations for its intensive work style and ground-breaking implementation of unique projects based on its (organisation's) key vital researches on the above mentioned topics.  
It is worth mentioning that the ECOSOC is at the 'heart of the United Nations system' to advance the three dimensions of sustainable development - economic, social and environmental. # Programme to tackle malnutrition in govt schools serving up some healthy results

New Delhi: A year since the implementation of a programme to tackle malnutrition in Delhi government schools, the Directorate of Education has recorded some positive results. DoE claimed an increase of 5kg and above among 68.3% of the students and a height increase of 15 cm and above among 43.4% of the students.

In November 2022, DoE conducted a survey of the height and weight of each government school student. The findings were analysed using WHO-Anthro Plus software. A total of 4,08,033 students in over a thousand schools were identified as falling in the red zone of suspected malnourishment.

Collaborating with Laadli Foundation, DoE began an intervention to tackle the problem. The measures taken included an introduction in the

midday meal of alternative dishes with high nutritional value, mini snacks break, maintenance of height and weight record of each student, parental counselling, especially at the parent-teacher meetings, and regular health check-up. For the mini snacks break, each school had its own menu, mostly pulses, sprouts and fruits.

"The improvement in height and weight is a big impact of the intervention. We have been able to reinforce positive behaviour among the students," said Himanshu Gupta, director, DoE. "This has increased awareness among all stakeholders towards the importance of nutritive food. There was a positive development among students regarding increased attention span, physical activity and comprehension. The attendance of the students falling in the red zone also improved."

In the next phase of the in-

tervention, blood tests and nutritional assessment of students still in the red zone are being conducted. Tata Img is collaborating with DoE on this. Once the initial test is conducted, proper me-

dical diagnosis will be done to determine if the child has anaemia or has other medical issues. Necessary medical advice will be provided to them. Among the districts, it is mostly in North-East that the

students have been found to be malnourished. In Government Girls' Senior Secondary School, Karawal Nagar, around 1,597 students have been identified as malnourished and around 1,659 in GBSS, Karawal Nagar.

"We have also formed a monitoring wing to ensure the project is properly implemented," added Gupta. "Each officer has been designated to visit two schools every day and file a report from each of the schools. There will be routine monitoring of the height and weight of students. Parental counselling and the mini snacks breaks will also continue."

And then, as the project goes into its second phase, the analysis of the health of new students joining the schools with the WHO-Anthro Plus software will continue. "DoE's ultimate aim is to end malnutrition among government school students," said Gupta.

## Health camp detects two HIV positive cases in Noida

Two women in Noida were found HIV positive during a health check up camp organized here in Harola basti of Noida sector-6, keeping their identities confidential both were registered with the Uttar Pradesh State AIDS Control Societies (UPSACS).

The camp comprised free health check-up, personal hygiene awareness and kit distribution for women and young girls being organized as part of Bharat Petroleum's CSR initiative by Laadli Foundation Trust and UPSACS.

As many as 1,498 local women and adolescents participated in the programme. The participants, after health and blood tests, were made aware of various infectious diseases and their avoidance. Following the awareness session, personal hygiene kits with the necessary medicines were distributed among the participants.

Beverlín Kumar Gupta, founder of the trust, said that in the camp, some ques-

tions were raised through questionnaires regarding sexual infections, whose statistics were very shocking as more than 90 per cent of women were lacking awareness on the subject. Most women do not know anything about sexual protection and sexual infections and HIV. During the camp, blood samples of all women were taken, in which more than 75 per cent of women were diagnosed with anaemia and pathological leukorrhea. Shockingly two were detected HIV positive. Further outline will be prepared with the help of the State AIDS Control Society and Bharat Petroleum.

This program was organized under the Laadli Foundation's Sabli program, which was attended by Bharat Petroleum's General Manager Mr. Lalit Watts, Mr. B V Gokhale, Mr. Rajesh Kashyap and Mrs. Shisha. Social workers Dr. Geet Kohli, Mr. Akshin Tandon and Mrs. Rupal also attended the programme.

Local women were very

enthusiastic about the program. A few of them noted that such camp has been organized for the first time here, wherein several important information along with medical check-up, was explained in a very simple manner. They admitted that they were not aware of these insightful facts, especially the young girls, who don't know much about the infectious diseases and importance of personal hygiene.

Speaking about the programme, founder of the Laadli Foundation, Beverlín Kumar Gupta said that because of the unawareness about the menstrual cycle and due to lack of information about infectious, women on many occasions take medicines without blood tests and medical advice, and further develop serious diseases. So far more than 65 thousand women and young girls living have been benefited with such camps organized by the Laadli Foundation across the country. Convener of the pro-

gramme Mr. Brahma Prakash Prajapati said that the program has been initiated in order to make women and young girls aware about the various aspects associated with personal hygiene and to get health check up at the right time.

During the programme, members of Amita Theater Group staged various 'nutals' targeting to aware the participants about the 'nutals'.

On the occasion Mr. Vratkesh Gupta, Mr. Bharat Bhusan, Mr. Chandrapal Barua, Dr. Sanjay Gupta, Mr. Pankaj Jain, Mr. Rajkumar Gohwal, Mr. Jyoti were also present. Adolescent girls in these regions face challenges including limited access to safe menstrual products, inadequate gender-segregated toilets, poor disposal systems, restricted SRH awareness, and deeply rooted stigma. These smart toilets are equipped with real-time monitoring systems, ozone disinfection, and water-saving technology, and are built using eco-friendly Wood Plastic Composite (WPC) to promote recycling and climate resilience.

SAHELI responds through an integrated, infrastructure-plus-education model that strengthens both knowledge and enabling environments ensuring girls can manage their health safely, confidently, and with dignity.

The Ladli Foundation has introduced AI-integrated Smart Swachhalay facilities in Jammu, Vijaypur, Pune, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Delhi to promote safe, hygienic, and dignified sanitation for students and marginalised communities. The AI-powered toilets feature automated monitoring and maintenance systems to ensure cleanliness and safety, particularly benefiting young female students. These smart sanitation units incorporate DRDO bio-digester technology, solar power, smart water conservation systems, automatic odour detection, and auto-jet cleansing, making them sustainable and eco-friendly. The initiative aims to provide smart, safe, and sustainable sanitation infrastructure in underserved areas, improving hygiene and dignity for marginalised communities. It also supports Ladli Foundation’s commitment to public health, environmental sustainability, and social inclusion, contributing to key United Nations Sustainable Development Goals related to clean water and sanitation, sustainable cities, and improved community health outcomes.

Building on this impact, the Institute for Future Skilling in Chhatrapur, New Delhi, launched in 2025 in collaboration with education and mission partners, provides free, industry-aligned training in AI, cybersecurity, data analytics, web development, digital marketing, communication, resume building, and interview preparation. The institute primarily supports unemployed youth, first-generation learners, girls, transgender students, and other marginalized groups by offering inclusive learning spaces, scholarships, placement-linked training, internships, mentorship, and entrepreneurship support.

# FINANCIAL & DIGITAL LITERACY EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM FOR WOMEN

The Financial and Digital Literacy (FDL) Empowerment Program for Women is a one-year initiative implemented by Ladli Foundation Trust with the support of Network People Services Technologies Ltd. (NPST).

The program focuses on strengthening financial awareness, digital confidence and economic participation among 10,000 women from underserved communities across urban, rural, rural-cluster and urban-cluster areas. It is being implemented in Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra, covering districts such as Lohardaga, Ramgarh, Gorakhpur, Maharajganj, Siddharth Nagar, Moradabad, Deoria, Pune, Satara, Kolhapur, Thane, Palghar and Mumbai. Through one-day interactive training sessions, women are introduced to practical concepts including savings, budgeting, mobile banking, UPI payments, insurance awareness, government financial schemes and safe digital transactions. The sessions use simple explanations, hands-on demonstrations and real-life examples to help participants apply the learning in their everyday lives. With continued follow-up and assessment, the initiative supports women in making informed financial decisions, safely using digital services and participating more actively in the formal financial ecosystem. The program contributes to building financially aware, digitally confident and economically empowered women who can strengthen their families and communities.

# JOSH- Making India Drugs and Crime Free

“JOSH” is designed to divert Young Boys, delinquents, and juveniles, and at-risk boys from substance abuse and criminal activities by involving them in sports, fitness, dance, YOGA activities, and mental health cum career counseling. It is especially designed to reduce access to substance use and crime, provide young boys with productive and useful tools, and make them an asset to society. The program targeted young boys residing in slums and underdeveloped areas of Delhi due to an ever-growing increase in substance use and crime. The focus also extends to dark hours due to the prevalence of crime and substance use in them and the onset of anti-social activities during the time of day, making it even more impactful. The idea of choosing sports, fitness, dance, and Yoga to divert them from substance use is its recognition as a means of fun and relaxation, attraction of individuals across all age groups, and its scientific significance, making the body release hormones such as dopamine and endorphin, leading to reduction of stress and anxiety among individuals and instillation of positivity in all.

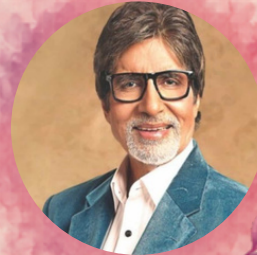
